

PUBLIC NOTICE - LICENSING ACT 2003

Take notice that Nick Richardson and Jessica Webber have applied to Pendle Borough Council under the Licensing Act 2003 for the grant of a Premises Licence in respect of the premises known as The Conservative Club - to be known as the venue, 105 Albert Rd, Colne, Lancs. BB8 0BS.

The proposed licensable activities are as follows:-

Provision of regulated entertainment:

a) Plays - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

b) Films - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

c) Indoor sporting events - 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

d) Live music - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

e) Recorded music - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

f) Performance of dance - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

g) Making music - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

h) Dancing - between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

Provision of late night refreshment between 2300-0000 Mon - Sun

Supply of alcohol between 0900-0000 Mon - Sun

One additional hour at the end of the normal licensing hours for New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Easter Monday, May Bank Holiday, Spring Bank Holiday, August Bank Holiday, 4 day Colne Annual Blues Festival, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day + Boxing Day. Two additional hours at the end of the normal licensing hours for New Year's Eve.

The place where the record of the application may be inspected and where the register of the Licensing Authority is kept is at Pendle Borough Council, Democratic and Legal Services, Town Hall, Market St, Nelson, Lancs. BB9 7LG. The record of the application may be inspected between 9.30a.m. and 12.30p.m. Monday to Friday.

An interested party or responsible authority may make representation in writing to the Legal Services Manager, Pendle Borough Council, Town Hall, Market St, Nelson, Lancs. BB9 7LG by 7th July, 2010.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is Level 5 on the standard scale, currently £5,000.
