

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CROWN POINT ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY
BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2009**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle or cycle from proceeding over that length of Crown Point Road, Burnley, from its junction with Woodplumpton Road, to its junction with Burnley Road, in the Borough of Burnley.

An alternative route for vehicular traffic and cyclists affected by the closure is via: -

Burnley Road - Bacup Road - New Road - Woodplumpton Road and vice versa.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times. The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed. The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cattle grid replacement works to be carried out.

The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours Wednesday 8th July 2009 until 1700 hours on Friday 31st July 2009, or until completion of the works within this period.
