

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(DANESHOUSE ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY
BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2009**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle or cycle from proceeding over that length of Daneshouse Road, Burnley, from its junction with Monkhall Street, for a distance of 22 metres in an easterly direction, in the Borough of Burnley.

An alternative route for vehicular traffic and cyclists affected by the closure is via: -

Brougham Street - B6434 Princess Way - A679 Active Way - A682 Colne Road - Hebrew Road.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times. The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed. The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow bridgeworks to be carried out.

The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 20th July 2009 until 1700 hours on Friday 4th September 2009, or until completion of the works within this period.
