

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CLIFTON STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 20****

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above traffic regulation order under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce No Waiting At Any Time, on the following lengths of Clifton Street, Burnley:

- i) On its easterly side, from a point 20 metres north of the centreline of Glen Street, for a distance of 73 metres in a northerly direction.
- ii) On its westerly side, from a point 80 metres north of the centreline of Glen Street, for a distance of 11 metres in a northerly direction.
