

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(REAR PARKINSON STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY
BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2009**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle or cycle or pedestrian from proceeding over that length of Rear Parkinson Street, Burnley, from its junction with Clarence Street for a distance of 30 metres in a southerly direction, in the Borough of Burnley.

This is a 'No Through' route and therefore no alternative route is applicable.

All surrounding properties are unoccupied. The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed. The temporary prohibition is necessary to prevent fly tipping, for security during demolition works and to allow safe demolition works to be carried out.

The prohibition will be operative from Monday 20th July 2009 until Tuesday 20th July 2010, or until completion of the works within this period.
