

**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ST MARY'S STREET, BRENNAND STREET,
CLITHEROE, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2009**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle or cycle from proceeding over the following lengths of:-

- i) St Mary's Street, Clitheroe, from its junction with Railway View Road to its junction with Waddington Lane;
- ii) Brennand Street, Clitheroe, from its junction with Railway View Avenue to its junction with Waddington Lane, in the Borough of Ribble Valley.

An alternative route for vehicular traffic and cyclists affected by the closure is via: -

Railway View Avenue – King Street – Station Road – Railway View Road – B6478 Waddington Road – Waddington Lane and vice versa.

Access to properties will be maintained. The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed. The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.

The prohibitions will be operative from:-

i) St Mary's Street closure

Friday 17th July 2009, Monday 20th July 2009 and Tuesday 21st July 2009 from 0800 hours until 1700 hours each day, or until completion of the works within this period.

ii) Brennand Street closure

From Wednesday 22nd July 2009 until Friday 24th July 2009, from 0800 hours until 1700 hours each day, or until completion of the works within this period.
