

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(HOWARD STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 20****

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed along Howard Street, Burnley, from a point 3 metres east of the centreline of Nairne Street for a distance of 2 metres in an easterly direction in the Borough of Burnley. The prohibition is to be effected by the erection of bollards.
