TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS ORDER (2009)**

TAKE NOTICE that the Secretary of State for Transport has given his approval for the above Order to continue in force for a further period of 12 months. The effect of the Order is to temporarily close to all traffic part of public footpath 28 Barrowford near Parrock Road at the site of the proposed Riverside Business Park. The section of footpath which is closed is a 90 metre section to the west of the new estate road heading towards Pendle Water. An alternative route is available by following the footway on the new estate road heading north, and then heading south east on a temporary footpath. The alternative route is approximately 170 metres. The closure is required because works are being carried out on the site to construct new office units, a car park and footpaths. This order will continue in force from 5th July 2009 until 5th July 2010.
