



**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER (OTHER THAN AN ACQUISITION
EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER)**

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

**PUBLIC FOOTPATH, 6 BROGDEN AND PUBLIC FOOTPATH 18 BROGDEN AND PUBLIC
FOOTPATH 1 BRACEWELL, PUBLIC FOOTPATH CREATION ORDER 2009**

On 30 June 2009 The Borough Council of Pendle confirmed the above order made under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to create a path from a point on footpath 6 Brogden at Grid Reference SD 8454 4700 (Point C) to run along an existing farm track to rejoin footpath 6 Brogden at Grid Reference SD 8461 4717 (Point D), and a path from a point approximately 62 metres west of Fools Syke House at Grid Reference SD 8464 4704 (Point J) to a bridge over Fools Syke Beck at Grid Reference SD 8468 4699 (Point L), and a path from footpath 18 Brogden at Grid Reference SD 8444 4716 (Point E) to footpath 6 Brogden at Grid Reference SD 8461 4717 (Point D), and a path from footpath 18 Brogden at Grid Reference SD 8439 4710 (Point G) to a farm track at Grid Reference SD 8464 4704 (Point J), and a path from a bridge over Fools Syke Beck at Grid Reference SD 8468 4699 (Point L) to 1 Bracewell at Grid Reference SD 8469 4698 (Point B) as shown on the order map. All distances approximate.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Nelson Town Hall, Market Street, Nelson 10.00 a.m. – 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.

The order comes into force 14 days after the date of confirmation of this order, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 10 July 2009, make an application to the High Court.
