Compulsory Purchase Order (part 2) 2008
COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND IN MANCHESTER
ROAD, BURNLEY**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Burnley Borough Council has made The Burnley (155 Manchester Road Burnley) Compulsory Purchase Order (part 2) 2008 under section 17 of the Housing Act 1985. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for confirmation, and if confirmed, the order will authorise Burnley Borough Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of bringing the property erected on the land back into residential use.

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, The National Unit for Land Acquisition, Planning and Housing Division, Government Office for London, Riverwalk House, 157-161 Millbank, London SW1P 4RR before 12 October 2009 and should state the title of the order and the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.

The dwellinghouse situate at Burnley, Lancashire together with the appurtenances thereto, known as 155 Manchester Road, Burnley.
