

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

**Town and Country Planning Act 1990,  
Section 257 and Paragraph 1 of Schedule 14**

**The Borough of Burnley (Footpath No.9)**

**(Worsthorne-With-Hurstwood) Public Footpath Diversion Order 2010**

The above order was made on 14th January 2010. The effect of the order will be to divert the public footpath running from point A on the plan attached to the order, being the junction of the said footpath with Hall Street, Worsthorne, Burnley at Ordnance Survey grid reference SD87393241, in a north-westerly direction for 125 metres, to point B on the plan attached to the order, being the junction of the said footpath with Footpath No. 10 (Worsthorne-with-Hurstwood) at Ordnance Survey grid reference SD87283247 and to create an alternative footpath instead on a line running from the said point A on the plan attached to the order in a generally northerly direction for 45 metres to point C on the plan attached to the order (Ordnance Survey grid reference SD38783244) then in a north-westerly direction for 60 metres to point D on the plan attached to the order (Ordnance Survey grid reference SD87333247) and then in a westerly direction for 53 metres to its junction with Footpath No.10 (Worshorne-with-Hurstwood) at the said point B on the plan attached to the order.

Any representation about or objection to the order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Head of People & Law, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley BB11 1JA not later than 15th February 2010. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council of the Borough of Burnley may itself confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
