## DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE SECRETARY OF STATE hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highway (North West) (No.6) Order 2010" authorising the stopping up of the whole of the unnamed highway which runs to the south of the boundary of No. 62 Windy Bank and to the rear of Nos 62 – 68 Windy Bank and which connects Windy Bank to Windsor Street at Colne, in the Borough of Pendle to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Sainsbury's Supermarkets PLC by Pendle Borough Council on 9 December 2008 under reference 13/08/0569P.

ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY THE ORDER and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 12 March 2010 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
