

The Burnley (Cog Lane, Burnley No's 1 & 2 Clearance Areas) Compulsory Purchase Order 2010



COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND IN COG LANE BURNLEY

NOTICE is hereby given that the Burnley Borough Council has made The Burnley (Cog Lane, Burnley No's 1 & 2 Clearance Areas) Compulsory Purchase Order 2010 under section 290 of the Housing Act 1985. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for confirmation, and if confirmed, the order will authorise Burnley Borough Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of undertaking or otherwise securing the demolition of buildings in a clearance area.

A copy of the order and the accompanying map may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Offices of Burnley Borough Council, Contact Centre, Parker Lane, Burnley and are available for view on the Council's website at www.burnley.gov.uk

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, The National Unit for Land Acquisition, Planning and Housing Division, Government Office for London, Riverwalk House, 157-161 Millbank, London SW1P 4RR before 19 April 2010 and should state the title of the order and the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

The dwellinghouses situate at Burnley, Lancashire together with the appurtenances thereto, which are listed as follows:

Clearance Area No. 1

Cog Lane, Burnley – dwellinghouse numbered 334

Cog Lane, Burnley – dwellinghouses numbered 338 and 340

LANDS OUTSIDE THE CLEARANCE AREA

Cog Lane, Burnley – dwellinghouse numbered 336
