

WATER INDUSTRY Act 1991 (s76) – Revocation of hosepipe prohibition. On Friday 9 July 2010 United Utilities Water plc (United Utilities), statutory water undertaker in the North West of England, imposed a hosepipe prohibition i as respects part of the area it supplies ii of the use of any water supplied by United Utilities for the purpose of watering private gardens or washing private motor cars drawn through a hosepipe or similar apparatus. Notice is hereby given by United Utilities that the hosepipe prohibition will cease from 00:01 on Thursday 19 August 2010. Postcodes in Cumbria affected by the above prohibition were as follows: CA 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, LA 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23. Outside of Cumbria the prohibition extended to all postcodes within the remainder of the United Utilities water supply area.
